SECRETARY'S REPORT

Insurance Professionals of Roanoke met Thursday, August 19, 2010, at Roanoke Country Club. President Julie Jones called the meeting to order at 6:02 pm and introduced the officers. Danielle Cranwell read the collect. Total attendance: 14 members, no guests.

Following items were discussed:

- 1) The Annual Budget for 2010-2011 was discussed with the following comments: Ann Huddleston said the 30.00 initiation fee for new members was not a new item; it just needs to be implemented. Changing the member annual dues from 33.00 to 35.00 was also not new; it just needs to be implemented. No local dues are required for retired members. Old Salem Days was left out of the budget, but enough members said they could volunteer for that event so it may be added. Margaret Wilson felt that the expenses were too high against the projected income. Sonya David suggested the use of the education funds, if needed. Ann suggested reduction of the National Conference down from 2,500.00 to 2,000.00. Added 400.00 to Ways & Means. Julie reminded everyone that the budget is just a guideline. The budget was voted on and approved with the above changes with expenses at 16,702.00 and income at 17,036.00. Motion to approve was made by Sonya and Kim Elliot seconded the motion. No prior meeting issues to discuss since the last meeting was the Appreciation dinner.
- 2) The Treasurer' report was filed for audit.

Committee Reports:

- 1) Sonya thanked everyone for their response on the golf address mailing list she had circulated by email for changes. It was mentioned that Pinkerton will provide the Hole in One car for the golf tournament. Extra billing will be available this year for the hole sponsors.
- 2) Teresa Sloan mentioned that there was a staff change at Roanoke Country Club. There is a new Chef and new contact for her reservations. The meal selection for future meetings will be posted on the website. Also, name tags are ready to be ordered with a 35.00 set up fee paid by the IPR and 13.00 name tags to be purchased by each member. The tags are white and have the IPR logo with has a magnetic back.
- 3) Melissa Maddox will look into a new shirt manufacturer to have shirts with IPR logo available in time for the golf tournament.
- 4) Ann asked for someone to type the by-laws. Sonya volunteered to help with this project.
- 5) Kim suggested we sell Rada Cutlery knives to raise money as was done in the past successfully.
- 6) Everyone discussed and agreed to continue with the gift bags for invited guests.
- 7) Carolyn Gearhart reminded everyone that they are invited to the ServPro open house on August 27, 2010.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 7:26 pm
